Procedure for Awarding Scholarships

Purpose

The Nurses Foundation of Wisconsin, Inc. awards scholarship money annually to Registered Nurses in Wisconsin who are continuing their education to obtain a baccalaureate or advanced degree in nursing. The purpose is to provide financial assistance to nurses who demonstrate the potential of making a contribution to nursing in Wisconsin. The maximum award is \$1,000 per application. Money to fund the scholarships is obtained through donations to NFW and other methods of fundraising.

Criteria for Selection of Recipients

1. Holds a valid RN license in Wisconsin.
2. Membership in WNA.
3. Acceptance by a program or school of nursing.
4. Demonstrates potential to make a contribution to nursing in Wisconsin
5. Demonstrates a financial need.

Procedure

1. Announcement of the availability of the scholarship is made to all Schools of Nursing in Wisconsin, in STAT and other appropriate places from September to January each year.
2. Applications **MUST** include:
 - the completed face sheet
 - copy of the Wisconsin Certificate of Registration
 - evidence of WNA membership,
 - evidence of acceptance/enrollment in a program or school of nursing,
 - curriculum vitae or resume,
 - letter that identifies professional goals and how the applicant plans to affect nursing care in Wisconsin, progress in their course of study and a summary of financial need,
 - two letters of support that address the applicants qualifications,
 - written description of financial need.
3. Completed applications are accepted until **May 1**.
4. Applications are reviewed by the NFW Scholarship Committee and recommendations for awards are presented to the NFW Board of Directors at the May/June meeting.
5. The President of the Foundation notifies all applicants of the outcome of the awards process.
